R of Moldova Country Programme for the enagement with GCF

- Country Programme (CP) for the engagement with GCFstrategic framework in collaboration with GCF.
- CP-developed by the NDA through Readiness Programme and Preparatory Support Programme.
- Objective of the CP- fostering country's ownership and development of a programmatic approach in accessing GCF funds.
- Getting existing and prospective Accredited Entities to identify practical steps that will enable the implementation of country's priorities for further support by the Fund.

Country-driven approach


- CP- developed through a country-driven approach led by the NDA to identify the strategic approach by which the country will address climate change, and provide broad oversight of the Fund's activities in the country.
- CP developed through an inclusive stakeholder consultation process across all levels of government: CPAs, LPAs, private sector and civil society to put forward country-owned priorities that GCF can support.







Size of project/activity within a programme











Country's agenda in the engagement with GCF

• Institutional arrangement in the engagement with GCF:

- MARDE/GCF NDA
- Use of inter-institutional Climate Change Coordination Mechanism chaired by the National Commission on Climate change in NDA's decision making
- Priority investment options of Moldova's adaptation and mitigation components in the country's engagement with the Green Climate Fund
- Country's investment pipeline
- Country's capacity building through Readiness Programme

Access to GCF resources through AEs

- Access to GCF resources through accredited national and international implementing entities and intermediaries.
- Entities seeking accreditation to the Fund in order to access its resources are assessed against the Fund's fiduciary principles and standards, environmental and social safeguards and gender policy.
- Direct Access Entities- Simplified approval process.
- Accreditation MasterAgreement signed between GCF and AE (GCF/B.12/23)

Partnership between NDA and AEs

- Accredited Entities to GCF and countries are key partners to promote mitigation and adaptation concrete actions on the ground.
- Country ownership is a central pillar of the GCF and this translates into action through strong partnerships between countries and entities.
- NDA-AEs collaboration before and after Funded Activity Agreement (FAA)
- NDA oversight over implemented in the country GCF projects.
